One of the most important challenges faced by farmers in Liberia is limited transportation options to get their produce from farm to market. Farmers face severe post-harvest losses as good crops waste away without any means to get to market. This preventable issue creates increased poverty, and malnutrition for the consuming public.

On a small scale, Frederick Hill of Seed Liberia has successfully solved this problem with a single Basic Utility Vehicle (BUV) which he placed on his farm for a few years. Now, Frederick and his ministry partners want the BUV to be the seed for success throughout Africa. He aims to expand so others can improve their quality of life. He needs to scale up his operation with several BUV/FarmToMarket (FTM) Tractors.

Our plans include spiritual / discipleship training of the owner operators / drivers. We have started training the trainers.



### Proposed Plan: BUV Business Fleet



The Basic Utility Vehicle (BUV) uniquely solves the transport problem faced by Liberian farmers. BUVs travel the backroads of "potential" in Africa and bring forth opportunity. Robust, easy to maintain vehicles represent a first mile solution for the small-holder farmers. Reliably serving for over 20 years in 37 countries, the BUV goes where the roads have no name, and obstacles lurk at every turn.

In 2024, Frederick and his pastor friends plan to order 1 built BUV and 4 BUV Kits with the tools to build the kits and launch a maintenance shop. A microfactory is in their long-range plans.

#### Our Appeal

\$55K USD to fund a 5-unit pilot fleet with 1 completed vehicle and 4 Kits to be finished in Liberia. The goal is to appeal for a grant for the launch of a BUV/FTM Tractor business with local owner operators or hired drivers.

### SEEDing the market: BUV Microfactory

As fleet operations in Liberia begin, others will soon observe the successful impact and start asking: "How do I get one?"

Keeping up with increasing demand will lead to a local BUV Microfactory in Liberia one day. Nearby communities and neighboring countries can be served with units manufactured locally, rather than shipped from the USA.
